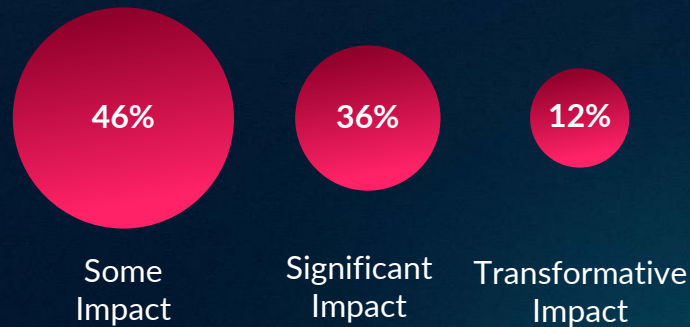
Australia and New Zealand lawyers have a good understanding of Generative AI tools and how they can be used...

... and expect AI to drive efficiencies with these time-intensive legal tasks.

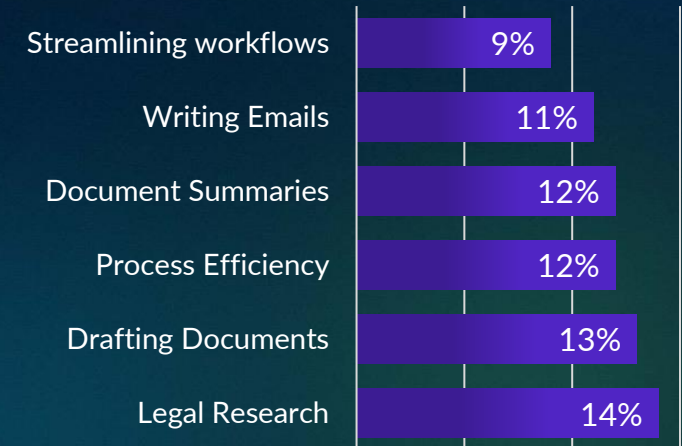
74% of Lawyers are either extremely or somewhat confident in understanding how Generative AI can be used in legal activities

Tasks where Lawyers see the most potential to use Generative AI



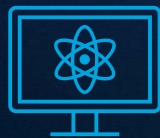

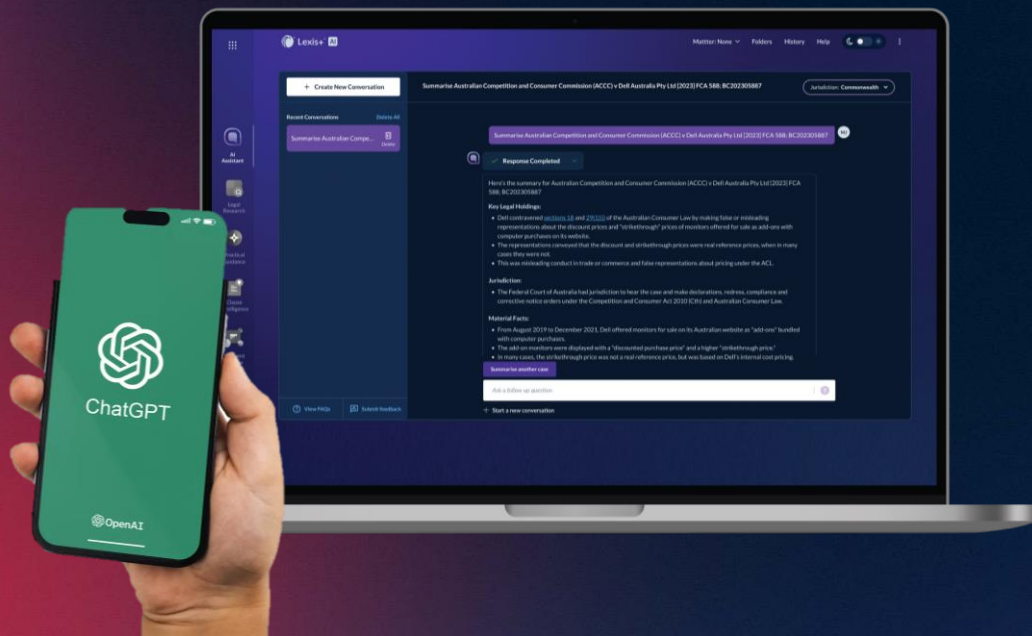

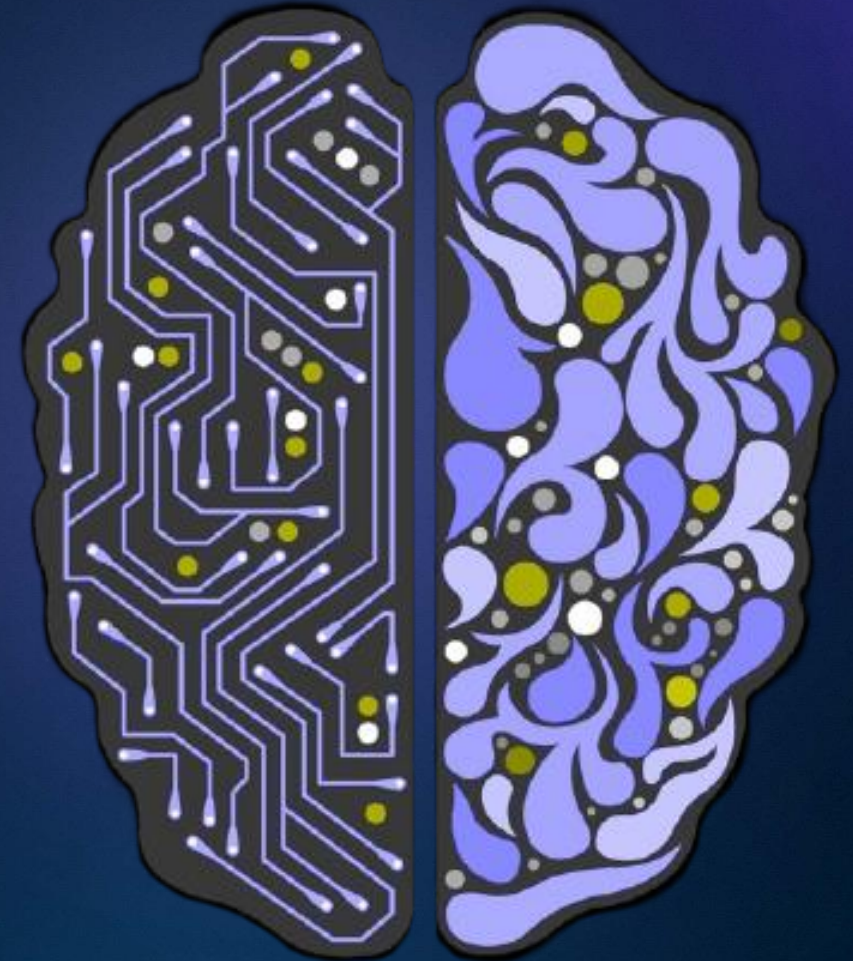
**AI that creates new content often

- Writes text, generates images & videos, composes music
- Holds back-and-forth conversations

Can you solely rely on generative AI?

- ✓ The response will always be your first “useful” draft
- ✓ The need to check & double check against citations will remain – ensure completeness, reliability and accuracy
- ✓ Use of traditional legal research in combination with generative AI responses will arm you with more objective and decisive data points

Large language models find “plausible” responses to your prompts. They not only lack the “reasoning” needed in legal research and strategy but also your expertise to address a matter that has come to you for a reason.

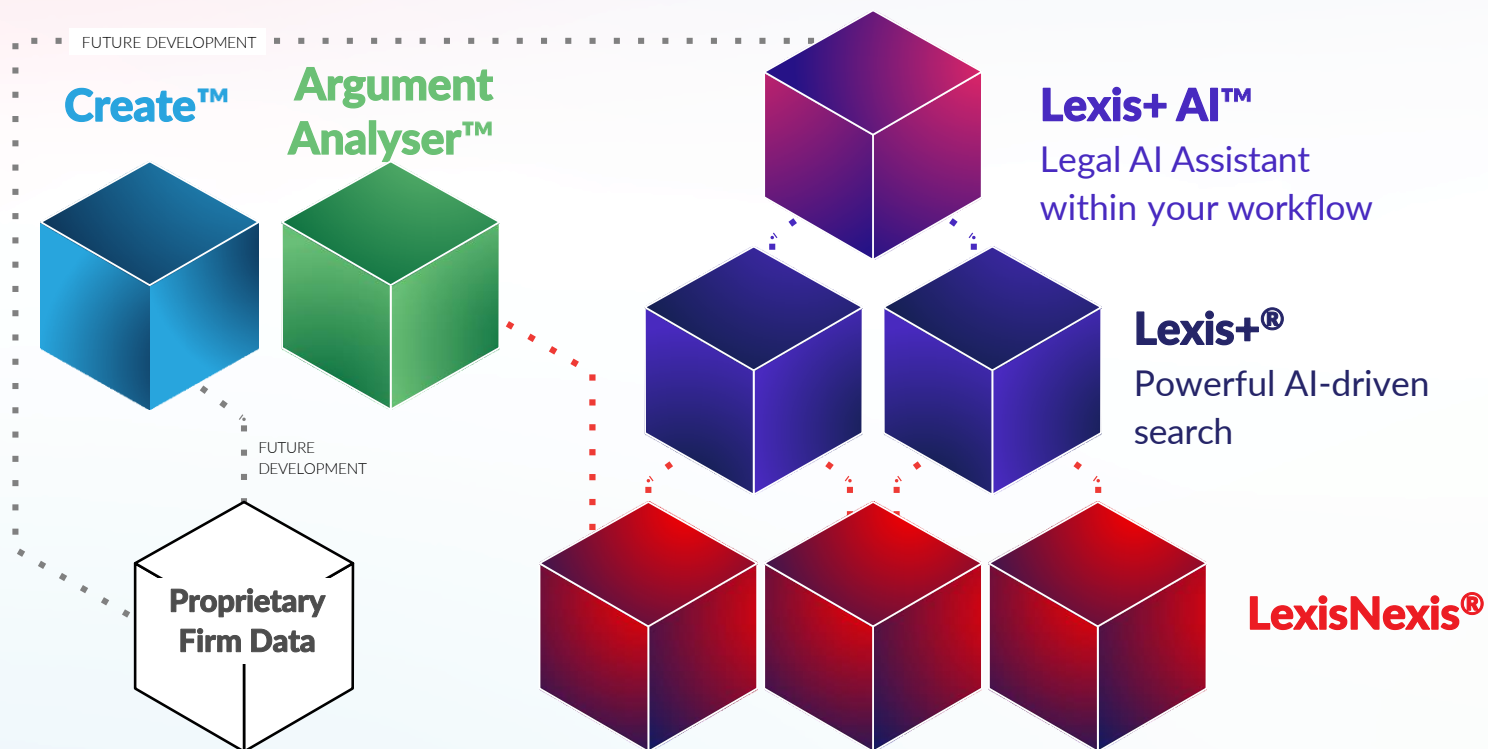

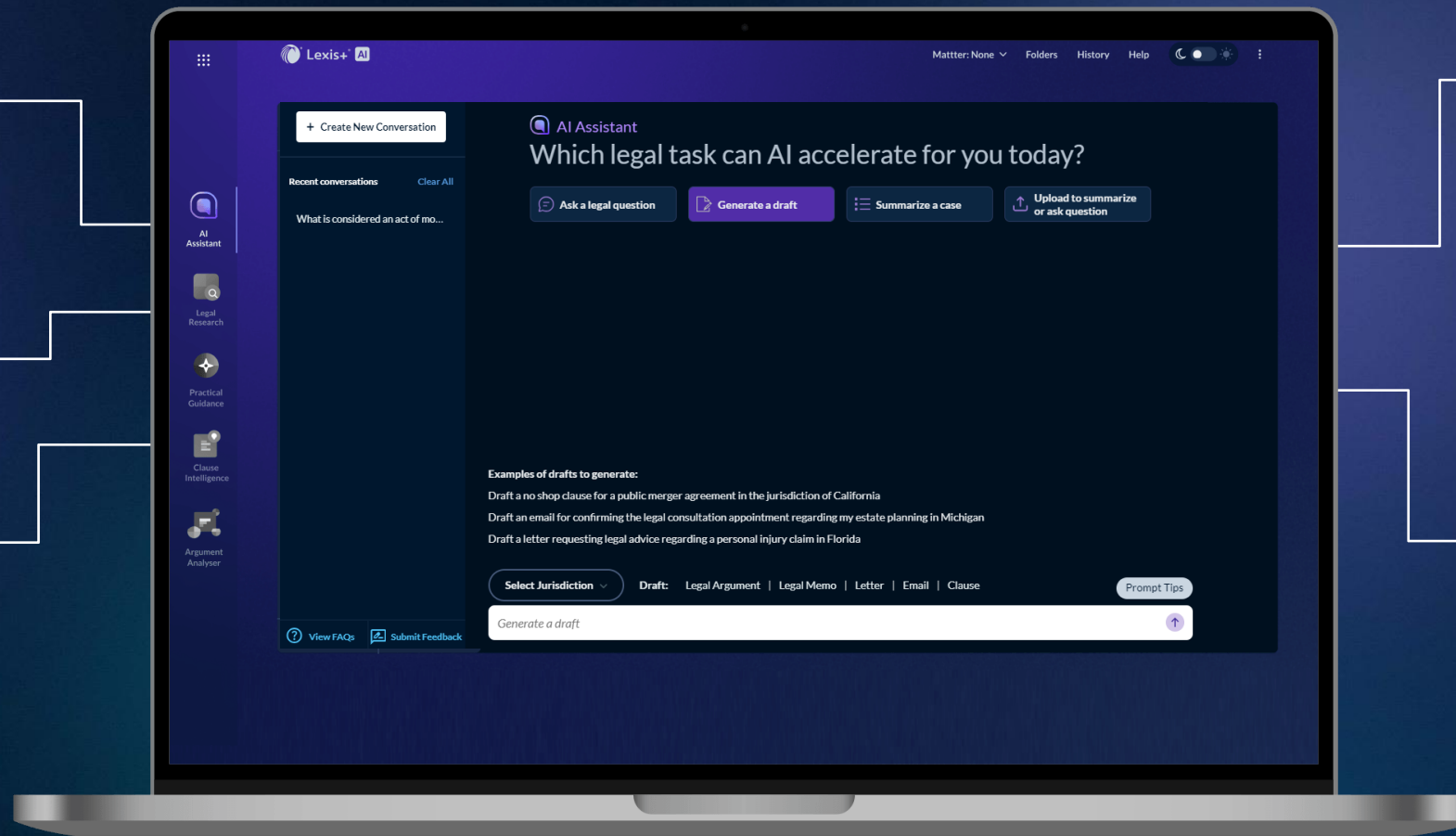

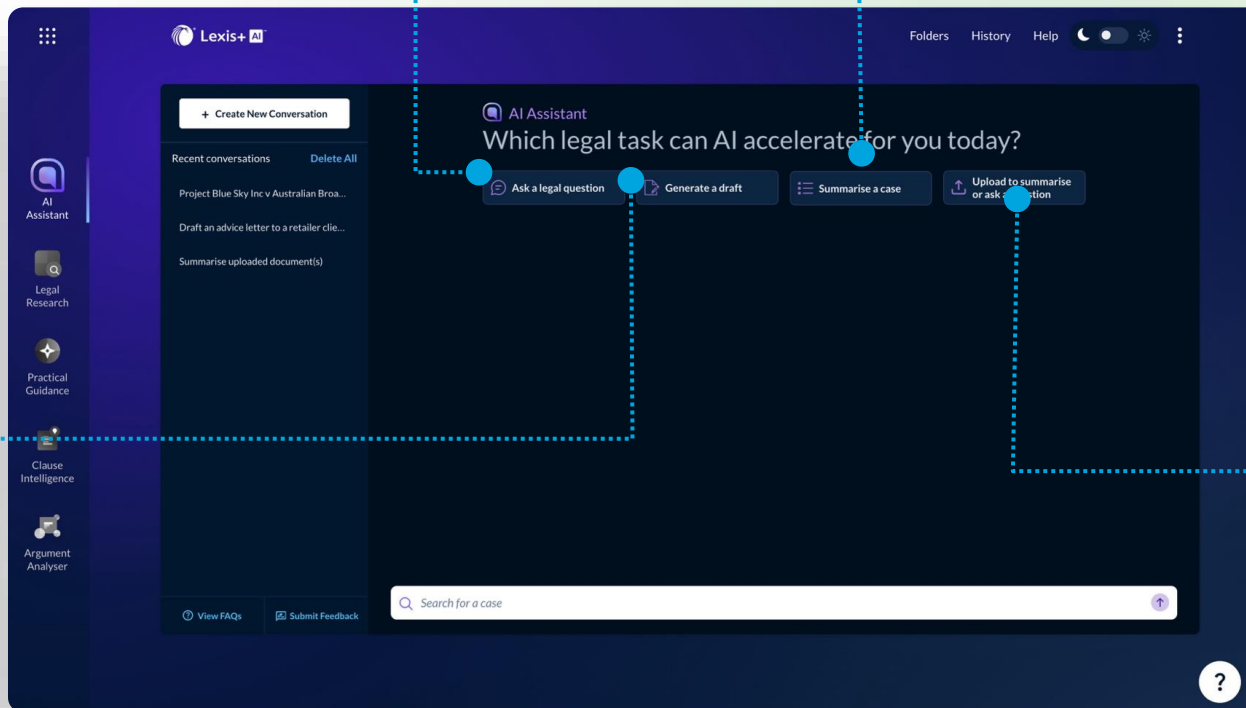
